Studies show we spend up to 90% of our time indoors. We spend 1/3 of our life in the bedroom; it should be the first room to make healthy-n-green.”

Denise Robinette is a licensed Interior designer, environmental health advocate and author. She became aware how important indoor air quality was after having children diagnosed with asthma over 13 years ago. After research, she developed healthy-n-green design principles in her own home and then started practicing them with her clientele. These design principles create a healthy indoor environment, one which promotes health, and helps protect our planet. Her passion as an environmental health advocate led her to co-found HealthyLiving Foundation, a 501-c-3, whose mission is to educate the public about indoor air quality. She developed educational tools (www.healthy-n-green.com) to empower children, students and families, so others may live in healthier homes, offices and public areas.
